## BB RED OLD ENGLISH

Beautiful bird with upright posture—popular within the show circuit. Originally from England. Produces small, cream-colored eggs. Fair egg yield between 100-120 per year.

## GOLDEN SEBRIGHT

Black lace plumage with gold feathering. Friendly and excellent pets. Produces small white to cream-colored eggs. Fair egg yield between 120-150 per year.

## MILLE FLEUR D'UCCLE

Unique plumage pattern with feathered legs. Friendly and excellent pets. Produces small white to tinted eggs. Fair egg yield between 100-120 per year.

## PORCELAIN D'UCCLE

Beautiful plumage with prismatic appearance. Friendly and excellent pets. Produces small tinted eggs. Fair egg yield between 100-120 per year.

## RED PYLE OLD ENGLISH

Upright posture with attractive reddish brown to white coloring. Originally from England. Produces small cream to pearly white eggs. Fair egg yield between 100-120 per year.

## SILVER SEBRIGHT

Typically not broody. Black lace plumage with white feathering. Friendly and excellent pets. Produces small white to cream-colored eggs. Fair egg yield between 120-150 per year.

## SILVER DUCKWING OLD ENGLISH

Upright posture with silver heads and wing tips. Great show bird. Produces small cream to pearly white eggs. Fair egg yield between 100-120 per year.

## WHITE SILKIE

Will go broody. Gorgeous dark skin with fluffy white plumage. Calm and easy to handle. Produces small tinted eggs. Fair egg yield between 100-120 per year.

## All About Bantams:

Often referred to as “mini” chickens, this tiny variety is ideal for small backyards. Typically, they weigh no more than 2 pounds. Bantams are suited to warm climates and will tolerate cold. Their eggs are about half the size of a standard chicken egg. Bantams and standard size chickens can be raised together. They go broody more often than standard size layers. They cannot be sexed.

With appropriate care, they can reach 4 lbs by 12 weeks of age and lay up to 100 eggs annually. A valuable addition to any farm or backyard flock.

## MALLARD

Mallards will hatch and raise their young, and they will likely fly away for the winter. Due to their small size and low egg yield, these birds are best suited for ornamental purposes.

## BUFF

A great dual-purpose bird. Friendly and suitable as pets. Ready for processing at 8 to 10 weeks, with a mature weight between 5 to 6.25 lbs. Can lay up to 180 eggs per year.



## CAYUGA

A beautiful breed with iridescent feathers. Suitable as a dual-purpose bird. Mature weight between 4.75 to 6 lbs. If properly managed, growers can expect 130-180 eggs per year.

## BLACK SWEDISH AND BLUE SWEDISH

# Chick Care

**Pickup and Arrival:** If possible, notify your post office that you are expecting live animals. Upon pickup, protect your chicks from drastic fluctuations in temperature (no direct air conditioning or heat) and ensure they are kept out of direct sunlight. Put your chicks in the brooder as soon as you arrive home.

**Brooder Space:** Set up your brooder prior to arrival. Your brooder and brooder area should be dry, pest-free, and draft-free. Ensure that the brooder as well as your enclosure have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to chick arrival.

**Warmth:** Infrared heat lamps are ideal. Keep your chicks at a steady 90-95 degrees for week one. Use a thermometer to check the temperature at floor level. Lower the temperature by approximately 5 degrees each week until your chicks are 6 weeks old, at which point you can start weaning them off external heat.

**Bedding:** We recommend 2-4 inches of pine shavings. Other options like newspaper, sawdust, or cedar are harmful to your chicks. Make sure your pine shavings are dry and free of mold before use.

**Water:** Chicks need to hydrate after arrival. Teach your chicks how to drink by gently dipping their beaks into room temperature water. Ensure that your waterer is shallow or filled with rocks to prevent drowning. Adjust the waterer height for your chicks as they grow.

**Feed:** Use a chick starter feed that is compatible with your type of bird. We recommend medicated feed if you choose not to vaccinate your chicks against Coccidiosis. Make sure food and water is plentiful and not directly under the heat source.
